ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLE SPEEDWAY CLUB CONSTITUTION

TITLE

The club shall be known as the Astley & Tyldesley Cycle Speedway Club, herein after referred to as the Club.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- 1. To provide and promote community participation in cycle speedway racing for all interested parties, using the track located adjacent to the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club, Meanley Road, Gin Pit, Tyldesley as the Club's base.
- 2. To develop and foster a spirit of comradeship and loyalty to the Club and its members.
- 3. To promote the highest standards of sportsmanship and to uphold the sport's ruling bodies' regulations, both in letter and in spirit.
- 4. To develop and encourage riders to enable them to fulfill their potential, both in individual and team events.
- 5. To continually strive to upgrade the Club's status and facilities for the broader benefit of the sport.
- 6. To safeguard the future of the Club within the sport's ruling bodies' rules and regulations.
- 7. To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.
- 8. To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

CLUB MEETINGS

The Club shall hold an annual general meeting for the election of officers who shall form the Club Committee and serve for a period of one year. Only fully paid up members are entitled to cast a vote at the annual general meeting. In addition, the Committee shall convene Club and/or Committee meetings at their discretion. Constitutional amendments shall require a two-thirds majority of persons present who are eligible to vote and can only be passed at an annual or extraordinary general meeting. Changes to rules and regulations, or any other matters arising, shall require a simple majority of persons present who are eligible to vote.

COMMITTEE

The Chairman shall head the Club.

The Secretary shall provide administrative services to the Club.

The Treasurer shall maintain the Club's accounts and be responsible for the collection of income due to the Club, and the payment of expenditure incurred by the Club.

The Team Manager(s) shall be responsible for the selection of teams for Club events, the organisation of the recruitment, training, coaching, discipline and motivation of riders, working closely with the Club's Coach(es).

The Club Captain shall liaise between the Team Manager(s) and the riders.

The Development Officer(s) shall be responsible for enhancing the status and facilities of the Club.

The Track Manager shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's facilities and equipment.

The Club Welfare Officer shall be responsible for ensuring the well-being of club members whilst participating in club activities.

The Committee shall be responsible for ensuring the efficient operation of the Club and may allocate specific duties to non-Committee members as appropriate.

Duties are described in greater detail in the Club's Job Descriptions and Match Day Officials' Duties documents.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all interested parties without discrimination in either an administrative, competitive or supporting capacity. The Club may refuse membership or expel from membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute. Appeal against such a decision may be made to the Club's members and decided by a majority vote. All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the Club will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the Club has adopted.

CHARGES

Users shall be liable for Track Access / Equipment Hire charges, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Charges will be paid per session.

FEES

All members of the Cycle Speedway Club shall be liable for payment of a membership fee, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Fees may be paid in a lump sum prior to the commencement of the season or in installments at each session or match. The annual fee for members aged 18 and over, shall include membership of the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club.

All racing members shall be liable for registration, affiliation and entry fees to the sport's ruling bodies. The appropriate fees will be paid in full in advance of the competition(s). In the event of non-payment, racing members will be unable to participate in the competition(s) in question.

NON-PROFIT MAKING

All surplus income or profits are re-invested in the Club. No surpluses or assets will be distributed to members or third parties.

DISSOLUTION

SIGNATURES

Upon dissolution of the Club, any remaining assets shall be given or transferred to another registered Community Amateur Sports Club, a registered charity or the sport's governing body, for use by them in community related sports.

Annual Report

Compilation of the Annual Report has been deferred until later in the winter, after completion of the Club's Business Plan and Development Plans and major grant application to Sport England. The annual Press Cuttings file was issued to the meeting.

The Club currently has a balance of £955.63 (£879.25 in the bank and £76.38 float). Total annual income was £4,036.25 and annual expenditure was £4,213.84.

Constitution and Rules

It was proposed and agreed that membership fees be revised, partly to increase income and also not to jeopardise grant applications through members not making contributions to club funds.

OFF TRACK REVIEW

The season got off to a bad start with the sad death of long serving club volunteer, Ron Hack.

Several changes were made to the Committee, with some new faces coming on board. Regular monthly club committee meetings were held during the year, but time spent resolving conflicts within the club throughout the year inevitably limited time available to drive the club forward. Brian Smith took over as Track Manager and along with the new Junior Team Manager, Brian Dickenson, worked hard in maintaining the club's facilities. Unfortunately, many of the facilities, in particular the Refreshments and Bike Cabins, are in dire need of replacing. Old and second hand items can only be repaired and patched up so often. We have now been waiting for nearly 5 years for our planned Facilities Re-development and the lack of funding has been a source of considerable disappointment to all in the club. The lack of funding from British Cycling and Wigan Council is disappointing, particularly in view of the millions spent in other cycling disciplines and on other sports clubs in the Borough. Once again, the absence of a Development Officer hasn't helped matters, with Paul Whitelegg resigning soon after being appointed last winter, along with Joanne Whitelegg, the Assistant Treasurer.

We are currently awaiting the outcome of a bid for £127,000 to Sport England's Community Investment Fund. We applied 12 months ago, but were told that the fund was fully spent up. However, not all funds allocated were used, so our application is currently being considered. We also applied to British Cycling in March for funding under the Whole Sport Plan, but were told that we had to secure match funding for the project. We are still awaiting details on their offer of assistance with that application.

We retained three club sponsors, whose support was welcome, but income received was down on previous years. Club finances are at their lowest level for many years, with insufficient income generated during the year to compensate for the extortionate legal fees paid to Wigan Council last winter.

The website continues to be a valuable information and promotional portal for the club. Plenty of professional standard press releases were issued and press coverage was much improved in the Leigh press, as well as increased internet coverage and a direct link from the Leigh Journal website. The club featured in an excellent four page article in Cycling Weekly magazine, when the Halfords Bikehut professional road racing team, led by former World Madison Champion, Rob Hayles, enjoyed a training session at Gin Pit.

The Club improved its links with Wigan Leisure & Culture Trust and Leigh Sports Trust, with Mike Hack assisting WLCT as the Cycling Team Manager for Team Wigan at the Gt. Manchester Champions Challenge. The Club finished the season with a record level of 60 club members (38 registered riders, 10 club night casual riders and 12 officials/volunteers) and continued to be a well organised set-up.

The Club successfully promoted the Women's British Club Championship and looks forward to promoting the British Individual Final in 2010, along with several other major meetings.

ON TRACK REVIEW

A large squad of riders was assembled by Team Manager Mike Hack for 1st team matches. Once again, the club faced the issue of many riders missing matches. Despite racing only 12 Northern League matches, 20 riders were used for the 1st team, by far the most of any team in the league. The fact that A & T was not the first claim or priority club for several riders was reflected in their availability and attitude to the club. After a great opening day win at the defending champions, Hull, we suffered several heavy defeats in mid season when the top end riders were absent. A late run of wins saw the club finish 4th out of 7 teams, for the second successive season. Dariusz Pilas topped the Northern League averages.

The team challenged to retain the Manchester League Division 1 title, before falling away in the last two rounds to finish 3rd out of 4 teams. A & T fielded a Women's team for the first time and finished 4th out of 6 teams in the Women's British Club Championship at Gin Pit.

The junior team enjoyed good results. A & T won the Manchester League Division 2 title, shocking Stockport to win the last round at Stockport and take the league title by 3 race points! The team finished 2nd in the Northern Junior League and 2nd in the Northern Regional Group of the British Youth & Junior League series. 11 A & T riders qualified for the national rounds of the BYJL, with 9 riders competing in each round. There were individual successes with Adam Phillips' victory in the U-12 British Grand Prix series and Adam Turnbull taking 3rd place in the U-8 series. Other individual successes saw Adam Watson win four U-10 competitions - Individual Finals and Grand Prix series in both the Northern League and Manchester League. Luke Jamson won the Northern U-19 Grand Prix series, with Ben Dickenson winning the Manchester League U-19 Grand Prix series. The team finished 3rd out of 5 teams in the Northern Combination League. It was a good effort by Brian Dickenson and Louise Watson in organising the junior team, with thanks to the riders' parents and grandparents for their support with transportation. A far cry from a decade ago!

The club continued to benefit from its ongoing recruitment initiatives, as numbers continued to rise at the Tuesday night junior training sessions. Gary Nuttall remained as coach, but work commitments restricted his availability, whilst Mike Hack took the Thursday night senior training sessions.

Joel Partington recorded major successes in other cycling disciplines, by winning four national titles - U-12 National Omnium Champion, U-12 National Omnium series, U-12 English Schools Cycling Association (ESCA) Hard Track Champion, U-12 ESCA Grass Track Champion.

In summary, the season repeated that of many previous seasons at Gin Pit plenty of new riders as a result of the hard work at recruiting riders good turn outs and successes at junior levels plenty of senior riders recruited but under achieved results,
due to insufficient commitment on the part of the senior riders.
