# **ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLE SPEEDWAY CLUB** **CONSTITUTION**

## TITLE

The club shall be known as the Astley & Tyldesley Cycle Speedway Club, herein after referred to as the Club.

## AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To provide and promote community participation in cycle speedway racing for all interested parties, using the track located adjacent to the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club, Meanley Road, Gin Pit, Tyldesley as the Club's base.
2. To develop and foster a spirit of comradeship and loyalty to the Club and its members.
3. To promote the highest standards of sportsmanship and to uphold the sport's ruling bodies' regulations, both in letter and in spirit.
4. To develop and encourage riders to enable them to fulfill their potential, both in individual and team events.
5. To continually strive to upgrade the Club's status and facilities for the broader benefit of the sport.
6. To safeguard the future of the Club within the sport's ruling bodies' rules and regulations.
7. To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.
8. To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

## CLUB MEETINGS

The Club shall hold an annual general meeting for the election of officers who shall form the Club Committee and serve for a period of one year. Only fully paid up members are entitled to cast a vote at the annual general meeting. In addition, the Committee shall convene Club and/or Committee meetings at their discretion. Constitutional amendments shall require a two-thirds majority of persons present who are eligible to vote and can only be passed at an annual or extraordinary general meeting. Changes to rules and regulations, or any other matters arising, shall require a simple majority of persons present who are eligible to vote.

## COMMITTEE

The Chairman shall head the Club.

The Secretary shall provide administrative services to the Club.

The Treasurer shall maintain the Club's accounts and be responsible for the collection of income due to the Club, and the payment of expenditure incurred by the Club.

The Team Manager(s) shall be responsible for the selection of teams for Club events, the organisation of the recruitment, training, coaching, discipline and motivation of riders, working closely with the Club's Coach(es).

The Club Captain shall liaise between the Team Manager(s) and the riders.

The Development Officer(s) shall be responsible for enhancing the status and facilities of the Club.

The Track Manager shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's facilities and equipment.

The Club Welfare Officer shall be responsible for ensuring the well-being of club members whilst participating in club activities.

The Committee shall be responsible for ensuring the efficient operation of the Club and may allocate specific duties to non-Committee members as appropriate.

Duties are described in greater detail in the Club's Job Descriptions and Match Day Officials' Duties documents.

#### MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all interested parties without discrimination in either an administrative, competitive or supporting capacity. The Club may refuse membership or expel from membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute. Appeal against such a decision may be made to the Club's members and decided by a majority vote. All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the Club will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the Club has adopted.

#### CHARGES

Users shall be liable for Track Access / Equipment Hire charges, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Charges will be paid per session.

#### FEES

All members of the Cycle Speedway Club shall be liable for payment of a membership fee, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Fees may be paid in a lump sum prior to the commencement of the season or in installments at each session or match. The annual fee for members aged 18 and over, shall include membership of the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club.

All racing members shall be liable for registration, affiliation and entry fees to the sport's ruling bodies. The appropriate fees will be paid in full in advance of the competition(s). In the event of non-payment, racing members will be unable to participate in the competition(s) in question.

#### NON-PROFIT MAKING

All surplus income or profits are re-invested in the Club. No surpluses or assets will be distributed to members or third parties.

#### DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the Club, any remaining assets shall be given or transferred to another registered Community Amateur Sports Club, a registered charity or the sport's governing body, for use by them in community related sports.

## **OFF TRACK REVIEW**

Several changes were made to the committee, with Brian Smith resigning for health reasons and Geoff and Linda Turnbull standing down after just one season. Paul and Joanne Whitelegg returned to the Committee and it was pleasing to report that all committee members were working in conjunction with each other.

Development Officer Mike Hack successfully obtained more than £3,000 funding from four providers. They were Wigan Council's Community Chest and Brighter Borough Fund, along with the Nine Lives Community Fund and the Rotary Club of Astley. This enabled the club to buy six intermediate sized bikes, install a CCTV security system, purchase a laptop and printer, along with a camcorder.

We continued to improve our facilities to further increase the value of our assets and all those who helped out can be pleased with our excellent British Team Finals promotion.

Unfortunately, we lost a sponsor in Tayban Development, after they went into liquidation, but retained CTA Direct, J. Fisher & Sons and Hypnotherapy4you as sponsors. The club turned over a sum of £7,614 and made a surplus of £1,273 on the year, to leave a healthy surplus of £2,184. This was largely due to the grants received and income generated from subscriptions and refreshment sales at our practice nights and match days.

The website continues to be a valuable information and promotional portal for the club. Plenty of professional standard press releases were issued and press coverage was good. The club continued to enhance its reputation as it continued to build up its contacts within the Wigan Borough. The club focused its efforts on building links with schools to recruit new members. It is hoped that this year's efforts will bear fruit in future years. The club also played host to several schools, clubs and groups, as well as participating in the Scouts & Guides Open Day at Astley St. Stephens and the Wigan Family Cycling Day at the Three Sisters Race Circuit.

Further afield, the club was featured worldwide, in front of an estimated total audience of 300,000, as the Match Day short film was shown worldwide as part of the New York Bicycle Film Festival.

Club Chairman Bill Phillips was recognised during the year, in receiving a British Cycling Volunteers Award, whilst Track Manager Lee Phillips took 2nd place in the Volunteer of the Year category at the Wigan Sports Awards. The undoubted highlight of the year was the club winning the Wigan Sports Club of the Year Award for the first time. This is a terrific achievement and accolade to all who have helped the club to develop over the past 22 years.

The club finished the season with 14 regular officials / volunteers and continued to be a well organised set-up.

## ON TRACK REVIEW

The club had taken the decision at the previous AGM to further its efforts on recruiting and coaching of local youngsters. This was to be achieved by working in conjunction with British Cycling Go-Ride Coaches and targeting local schools. To cater for the anticipated influx of new riders, the club organised two Go-Ride Racing series - the established Grand Prix series on Sundays and a new League for teams on Thursdays. The Tuesday club practice nights remained and they were well attended for most of the year. 39 riders (albeit including some from visiting clubs) competed in the A & T Go-Ride Grand Prix series. However, the A & T League was not well supported and will not be continued in 2012.

The club continued to cater for a wide range of rider (and parental) requirements, with some prepared to train and / or compete at Gin Pit only, some prepared to turn out on mid week nights only, some prepared to travel no further than Bury and Stockport, through to those who wished to train and race on a regular basis both in regional and national competitions. Riders were also able to compete in Manchester League Division 1 events, to enable riders to compete in some senior matches.

Some good results were recorded at junior levels, with the club finishing 2nd in the Northern U-12 section of the British Youth & Junior League and 2nd in the Manchester League 2nd Division. The team highlight was taking 3rd place in the U-13 British Club Championship Final at Hull. We were narrowly beaten in the final, after taking a win in the semi-final. The club finished 14th in the overall British Club Championship table, the same as the previous season.

Individually, we had three riders who qualified for the national rounds of the British Youth & Junior League, Thomas Whitwam, Max Evans and Adam Turnbull. Luke Jamson won the U-19 Northern Grand Prix series, whilst Adam Turnbull won the U-10 Northern Individual Final, the U-10 Northern Grand Prix series, the U-10 Manchester League Individual Final and the U-10 Manchester League Grand Prix series. Adam Phillips won both the U-13 Manchester League Individual Final and the U-13 Manchester League Grand Prix series, as well as the U-19 Manchester League Individual Final.

The undoubted racing highlight of the season was Adam Phillips' victory in the U-13 British Individual Final at East Newport. He was easily the best u-13 rider in the sport throughout the year and was a deserved British Champion - the 14th in the club's history - all recruited and trained within the A & T club.

The club has taken the decision to enter a team in the Northern Combination League in 2012 and it is imperative that the youngsters support the club in its bid to move up the racing ladder in team events.
