ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLING CLUB CONSTITUTION

TITLE

The Club is the Cycling section of the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Institute and Recreation Ground registered charity. For practical, branding and brevity purposes, the Club shall be known as the Astley & Tyldesley Cycling Club, herein after referred to as the Club.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To provide and promote community participation in cycle speedway racing and activities for all interested parties, using the track located at the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Institute and Recreation Ground, Meanley Road, Gin Pit, Tyldesley as the Club's base.
2. To enable club members to represent the Club in race events in all cycling disciplines.
3. To signpost interested parties to participate in informal leisure cycling activities.
4. To develop and foster a spirit of comradeship and loyalty to the Club and its members.
5. To promote the highest standards of sportsmanship and to uphold the sport's ruling bodies' regulations, both in letter and in spirit.
6. To develop and encourage riders to enable them to fulfill their potential, both in individual and team events.
7. To continually upgrade the Club's status and facilities for the broader benefit of the sport.
8. To safeguard the future of the Club within the sport's ruling bodies' rules and regulations.
9. To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.
10. To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

CLUB MEETINGS

The Club shall hold an annual general meeting for the election of three officers who shall form the Club Management Committee and serve for a period of one year. Only fully paid up members are entitled to cast a vote at the annual general meeting. In addition, the Management Committee shall convene Club and/or Committee meetings at their discretion. Constitutional amendments shall require a two-thirds majority of persons present who are eligible to vote and can only be passed at an annual or extraordinary general meeting. Changes to rules and regulations, or any other matters arising, shall require a simple majority of persons present who are eligible to vote. A Club meeting will be inquorate and therefore not take place if there are less than three individuals present.

MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The Chairman shall head the Club.

The Secretary shall provide administrative services to the Club.

The Treasurer shall maintain the Club's accounts and be responsible for the collection of income due to the Club, and the payment of expenditure incurred by the Club.

Generic Committee posts to complement and support the work of the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.

The Management Committee will be supplemented by Volunteers carrying out specific roles and responsibilities, either as individuals or groups, on a permanent or ad hoc/ project basis:

Team Manager(s) - selection of teams for Club events, organization of recruitment, training, coaching, discipline and motivation of riders, working closely with the Club's Coach(es);

Coach(es) – training, coaching and developing of riders at club sessions and matches;

Development - enhancing the status, publicity, promotion and facilities of the Club;

Facilities - maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's facilities and equipment;

Track Curator - maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's race circuit;

Club Welfare Officer(s) - ensuring the well-being of club members at club activities;

Go-Ride Contact – liaison with British Cycling relating to Go-Ride activities and events;

Recruitment - recruitment of new riding and volunteer members;

Catering Manager – purchase, preparation and sales of refreshments, kitchen maintenance;

Social Secretary(s) - organizing social and fund raising events;

First Aider(s) – provision of first aid at club sessions and matches;

Match Day Officials – to ensure the efficient organisation and delivery of a race meeting.

ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLING CLUB CONSTITUTION

The Management Committee shall be responsible for ensuring the efficient operation of the Club and will allocate specific duties to Volunteer members as appropriate. Duties are described in greater detail in the Club's Job Descriptions and Match Day Officials' Duties documents. Club members, or members of their family or friends, are required to assist with the running of events at Gin Pit, as directed by the Management Committee.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all interested parties without discrimination in either an administrative, competitive, casual or supporting capacity. The Club may refuse membership or expel from membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute. Appeal against such a decision may be made to the Club's members and decided by a majority vote. All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the Club will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the Club has adopted.

CHARGES

Users shall be liable for Track Access / Equipment Hire charges, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Charges will be paid per session.

FEES

All members of the Club shall be liable for payment of a membership fee, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the racing season. Fees may be paid in a lump sum prior to the commencement of the racing season or in installments at each session or match. The annual fee for members aged 18 and over, shall include membership of the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club.

All racing members shall be liable for registration, affiliation and entry fees to the sport's ruling bodies. The appropriate fees will be paid in full in advance of the competition(s). In the event of non-payment, racing members will be unable to participate in the competition(s) in question.

NON-PROFIT MAKING

All surplus income or profits are re-invested in the Club. No surpluses or assets will be distributed to members or third parties.

DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the Club, any remaining assets shall be given or transferred to another registered Community Amateur Sports Club, a registered charity or the sport's governing body, for use by them in community related sports.

Review of the Year and Financial Report 2022

General discussion took place of the year's activities, both on and off the track.

It was a very successful year, with the club winning five team trophies on the track. We had two more British Individual Champions, plus one more British GP series winner. We had the highest number of British Cycling registered members, of any cycle speedway club in the UK – 50. This was 10 members more than the next two clubs. We staged the 2nd highest number of BC registered events - 20. This was one behind the highest number. We had a hugely successful staging of the European Championships, over three days, our biggest promotion ever. We enjoyed excellent TV coverage on ITV's Granada Reports programme and a promotional event at the National Speedway Stadium in Manchester. Many facility improvements were made – replacing floodlighting, fitting safety netting, laying a French drain in the pits area, fixing hand rails and strengthening the spectator seating. We provided this year's Wigan Young Sports Achiever winner, with the Club being a finalist in the Club of the Year category.

Meeting accepted the Financial Report, noting that the club holds a current account balance of £8,495. The club generated income of £20,781, for a yearly surplus of £3,260.

OFF TRACK REVIEW

Following a highly successful 2022 season, both on and off the track, it was disappointing (and difficult to fathom why) that a large number of members left the club or the sport, for a variety of reasons.

We continued our programme of facility improvements and maintenance, in advance of the British Individual Finals staging. This included installing a new CCTV system, painting and treating of the three oldest cabin roofs, replacing and welding of support rails to spectator seating, to prevent further theft of materials, installation of a new P.A. system and speakers. The year's programme was finished off in the Autumn with completing the site external perimeter fencing, laying of grit and sand to the spectator area, re-laying the track with Broxburn shale.

The club benefited from receiving funding, sponsorship and donations for the facility improvements and to support the British Individual Finals staging. Wigan Council's Community Safety Fund provided £2,000, along with £789 from Forever Manchester, £500 from the Rotary Club of Astley, £250 from British Cycling's Summer of Cycling programme and £1,000 from a donor who wishes to remain anonymous. The club once again put on a great event with our British Individual Finals staging.

The club's income was £13,025, a yearly deficit of £764, to leave a balance of £7,732.

The Club was runner-up in Wigan's Club of the Year awards, whilst Frank White was a finalist in the Wigan Young Sports Achiever of the Year award.

Having lost riders and volunteers during the winter and early season, we continued our strong recruitment programme for new riders and volunteers. We hosted some Open Days and taster sessions, in conjunction with British Cycling's Summer of Cycling programme, MM Chinese Club and Atherton & Tyldesley Sports Association (ATSA). We also acquired two newly qualified Level 2 Cycle Speedway coaches, along with two more changes of Welfare Officer.

A small band of club officials and volunteers have succeeded in their determined efforts to ensure that the club remains strong. The Club has 43 members who are British Cycling registered members. A&T put on 21 official events during the season, just one behind the highest number of events by a cycle speedway club. Add in the number of club training events and taster sessions put on, and there is no question that A&T have continued to be one of the sport's leading clubs.

ON TRACK REVIEW

Our club training activities began in early February, with the racing season starting in mid March. Once again, we contested a full programme of competitive fixtures at all levels, through to the end of October.

Having enjoyed a highly successful season, by winning five team competitions in 2022, it was quite astonishing to see senior riders transferring to other clubs, and junior riders who were placed to step up, either dropping out or missing a large number of matches. Former British Champion Terry Norman was a welcome recruit, on loan from Stockport, for North & Scotland Regional matches. Not surprisingly, we struggled at times in 1st team matches. However, we retained our Manchester League Division 2 title and won the Northern Junior K.O. Cup. We again qualified for the National rounds of the British Youth & Junior League competition, and finished in 3rd place in the series, behind Kesgrave and Poole.

Our riders again enjoyed considerable successes in national individual competitions. Steve Harris won the British Indoor o-50 Individual Final and was 2nd in both the British o-50 Individual Final and the British o-40 Indoor Individual Final. John White took a fine 3rd place in the British Junior Individual Final and finished 2nd in the British u-18 Grand Prix series. Frank White continued his amazing run, by securing his eighth national title win, at the age of 12. Frank again won both the British u-12 Boys Individual Final and the British u-12 Grand Prix series.

Steve Harris was our lone representative in the World Championships in Australia. He finished 2nd in the World Grand Veterans Individual Final. Steve raced for the England and Gt. Britain Veterans teams which finished 2nd in the World Cup, World Best Pairs, Federations Cup and test series against Australia. John White was a member of the victorious England team in the Junior Home International at Newport.

Two riders represented the North & Scotland in the Battle of Britain matches – Steve Harris, Duncan Whalley.

We had several regional and local Individual and GP winners. John White won both the Northern and Manchester League u-19 Individual Finals, whilst Frank White did likewise at u-13 level. Duncan Whalley won the Northern u-16 GP series and Owen Simcock won the Manchester League u-19 GP series.

We once again staged our Club events – Individual Championships, Go-Ride series, Autumn Ladder League.

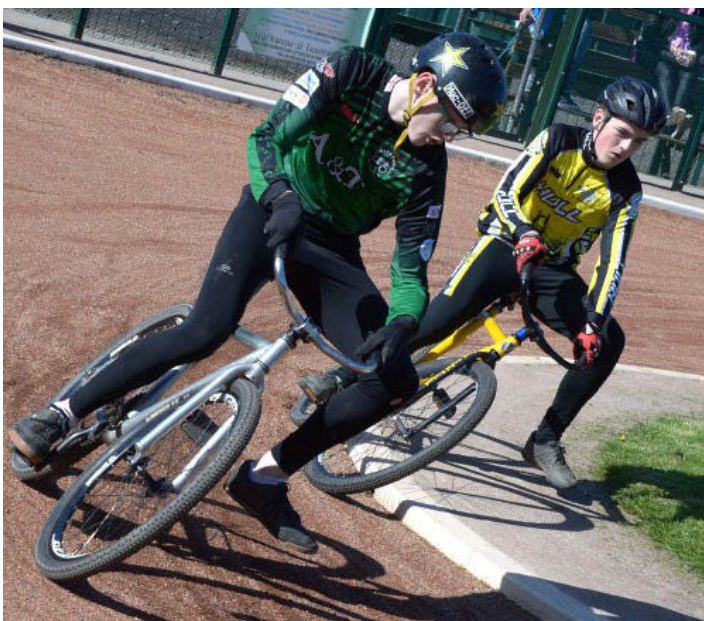

Some of our riders enjoyed racing in mountain bike cross country, track, closed circuits and cyclo-cross events, either wearing A&T club colours or those of other clubs.

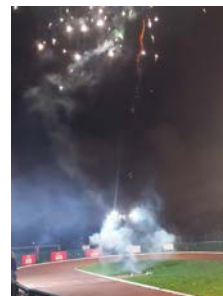
