MATCH DAY OFFICIALS - PITS MARSHAL

Main Purpose

- To provide organisation and order within the pits.

Main Duties

- Ensure pits area is clear and tidy prior to match.
- Ensure sufficient chairs and fresh drinking water are available for riders in the match.
- Maintain order in the pits throughout the meeting, remove unauthorised personnel.
- Notify referee immediately of any breaches of rules in the pits by riders or team managers.
- Ensure that riders do not leave the pits without permission.
- Organise pre-match on track warm up sessions and parade of riders.
- Ensure track gates are opened to afford access to from / pits, and closed to ensure safety during races.
- Team Event duties:
 - Check / complete riders' names in programme / scoresheet no later than 20 minutes prior to the match, either from referee or team managers.
 - Notify referee and announcer of changes to race line-ups.
 - Liaise between referee and team managers, as requested / directed.
- Individual Event duties:
 - Check / complete riders' names in programme / scoresheet no later than 20 minutes prior to the match, from referee.
 - Issue / collect riders' individual numbers.
 - Notify riders of their race and grid position prior to the referee's whistle blown.
 - Notify referee and announcer of changes to race line-ups.
 - Liaise between referee and riders, as requested / directed.

Equipment

- Chairs, Water Bottles, Clipboard, Pen, Scorechart, Arm Band, Riders' Numbers.

Dress Code

- Smart Casual (Club Jacket and/or Club Tee Shirt preferred) for most matches.
- Club Match Officials Dress (Union Jack Tee Shirt or White/Blue/Red Polo Shirt and Black Trousers) for major events.
